- ❖ Eligibility: Over the age of 18, homebound (unable to leave the home without considerable difficulty and/or assistance) and unable to meet basic nutritional needs either temporarily or permanently (unable to prepare/have difficulty preparing at least one nutritious meal daily because of physical or mental limitations, or unable to obtain/have difficulty obtaining necessary food), have no other reliable means of obtaining daily meals
