Tom Henry moved to approve and sign the Memorandum of Understanding with Energy Systems Group to do a Feasibility Analysis on negotiating the best natural gas rates when hookup is available. This does not lock the County in until a final contract again is signed. Rick Wilbur second the Motion. Motion carried.
