7. Commissioners participating in the Planning Committing Meeting on Thursday evening. All Façade applicants approved. Very good project.

The Commissioners discussed the opening of the Courthouse and the other Building on June 8, 2020 with the following restrictions:

1. All County employees in all County Building will return to work and will be required to wear a mask and have a Temperature Check before entering the County Buildings.
2. All Visitors will have a mask, a temperature check and an appointment for that day before gaining entrance. Extra Family members or others will not be allowed entrance to keep traffic down while business is being conducted.
